How to staple your document... (2. Copying)

Press the [Sort/Staple] key.

- **2** Select [Sort and Staple], and then press the [OK] key.
- **B** Select the staple position, and then press the [OK] key.
- Select the original orientation, and then press the [OK] key.
- **5** Enter the number of copy sets.
- I Place the originals and then press the [Start] key.

How to sort your copies...

- Press this key for Sort.
- 2 Select [Sort] or [Rotate Sort], and then press the [OK] key. (finisher not installed) Select [Sort and Staple] or [Rotate Sort], and then press the [OK] key.(finisher installed)
- **I** If you selected [Sort and Staple] in Step 2, select [Sort Only], and then press the [OK] key. (Otherwise, proceed straight to **(**.)
- Enter the number of copy sets.
- **9** Place the originals and then press the [Start] key.

Copies are assembled as sets in sequential order.

Rotate Sort

Every other copy set is rotated by 90° \square \square and delivered to the copy tray.
