SYMPTOM

The coordinates of the LCD touch screen are shifted when the machine recovers from Energy Saver mode.

Note: In some cases, this can cause a fax to be sent to the wrong destination.

CAUSE

Bug with LCDC firmware v1.03.

Due to a firmware bug, the machine switches to a two-point calibration when it recovers from Energy Saver mode. However, the LCD coordinates are not adjusted at the factory for a two-point calibration, since this model is designed to always use a five-point calibration. As a result, when the operator touches the screen, the coordinates detected by the machine may shift up to 8mm.

Change: Deodorizing filters were newly added as service parts for the AL-C1/AL-C1.5/AL-C2/AL-P1. **Reason:** To meet the requests of customers who may report strange odors on these models.

Note:

- In certain installation environments, come customers may have a relatively high sensitivity (low tolerance) to odors.
- The installation procedure and limitations of these filters are included below, as part of the **ACTION IN THE FIELD**.

ACTION IN THE FIELD

If a customer reports a strange odor from the machine, use the **flowchart below** to take the appropriate action.

A. Responding to the Customer

- 1. The first step in handling an inquiry about Ricoh device odor is to explain the following to the customer:
 - Ricoh takes our customers' health and the health of our planet very seriously. This is highlighted by the fact that Ricoh products receive the German "Blue Angel" and Japanese "Eco Mark" certifications. This level of dedication is standard at Ricoh.
 - This means that a properly used and maintained Ricoh product should never be the source of problem in the office environment, including those related to employee health. However, keeping the device in a small, improperly ventilated space or sitting directly in the path of the exhaust fumes has been reported to cause unpleasant odors, head and throat pain, and general discomfort. Therefore, we strongly urge customers to make sure that their devices are placed in areas with proper ventilation, and that the exhaust is pointed safely away from anyone sitting nearby. Ideally, this should be done during initial installation, but working with existing customers to improve the quality of their office environment should be done whenever possible.
 - However, brand new devices have a particularly strong odor that might worry some customers. This odor is significantly reduced by the end of the **first week of use**, so please ask for the customer's patience. See Figure 1 below for an example using the Aficio SP 8100DN.
 - Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) are particles of the component materials (glues, plastics, chemicals, etc.) that Ricoh devices are built with. VOC are the primary source of the odors produced by Ricoh devices, so tracking VOC levels produced by Ricoh devices is a good indicator of the strength of the odors. Figure 1 shows the VOC levels of a brand new Aficio SP 8100DN during the first 5 days of use. As the graph shows, the amount of VOC has dropped by almost 60%.





*1: Measurement was performed using a ppbRAE3000 from RAE Systems.

- *2: "VOC Level (%)" shows the VOC level on a given day as a percentage of the first day's level. Mathematically, this is expressed as [Level detected on a given day] / [First day's level]
- 2. After the customer understands the above, work with the customer to ensure that there is enough ventilation and that the Ricoh devices are installed in a safe and proper manner.

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B. Room ventilation

While Ricoh devices are certified as safe, ventilation in some offices can allow even the safe levels of *VOC produced by Ricoh devices to build to levels that produce strong odors and health effects. In such cases, it is necessary to improve the ventilation of the immediate environment in which the Ricoh device is installed, in order to reduce particle concentration levels.

D. Limitations of the deodorizing filters

- The Auto Off Timer should be set to its default value (60 minutes)

This is because when the temperature is this high, the properties and behavior of the toner change, and image quality issues begin to occur.

Change: Deodorizing filters were newly added as service parts for the AL-C1/AL-C1.5/AL-C2/AL-P1/ AL-P2.

Reason: To meet the requests of customers who may report strange odors on these models.

Note:

- In certain installation environments, some customers may have a relatively high sensitivity (low tolerance) to odors.
- The installation procedure and limitations of these filters are included below, as part of the **ACTION IN THE FIELD**.

ACTION IN THE FIELD

If a customer reports a strange odor on the machine, use the **flowchart below** to take the appropriate action.



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Action referenced in the Flowchart above:

A. Responding to the Customer

- 1. The first step in handling an inquiry about Ricoh device odor is to explain the following to the customer:
 - Ricoh takes our customers' health and the health of our planet very seriously. This is highlighted by the fact that Ricoh products receive the German "Blue Angel" and Japanese "Eco Mark" certifications. This level of dedication is standard at Ricoh.
 - This means that a properly used and maintained Ricoh product should never be the source of problems in the office environment, including those related to employee health. However, keeping the device in a small, improperly ventilated space or sitting directly in the path of the exhaust fumes has been reported to cause unpleasant odors, head and throat pain, and general discomfort. Therefore, we strongly urge customers to make sure that their devices are placed in areas with proper ventilation, and that the exhaust is pointed safely away from anyone sitting nearby. Ideally, this should be done during initial installation, but working with existing customers to improve the quality of their office environment should be done whenever possible.
 - However, brand new devices have a particularly strong odor that might worry some customers. This odor is significantly reduced by the end of the **first week of use**, so please ask for the customer's patience. See Figure 1 below for an example using the Aficio SP 8100DN.
 - Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) are particles of the component materials (glues, plastics, chemicals, etc.) that Ricoh devices are built with. VOC are the primary source of the odors produced by Ricoh devices, so tracking VOC levels produced by Ricoh devices is a good indicator of the strength of the odors. Figure 1 shows the VOC levels of a brand new Aficio SP 8100DN during the first 5 days of use. As the graph shows, the amount of VOC has dropped by almost 60%.





*1: Measurement was performed using a ppbRAE3000 from RAE Systems.

- *2: "VOC Level (%)" shows the VOC level on a given day as a percentage of the first day's level. Mathematically, this is expressed as [Level detected on a given day] / [First day's level]
- 2. After the customer understands the above, work with the customer to ensure that there is enough ventilation and that the Ricoh devices are installed in a safe and proper manner.



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B. Room ventilation

While Ricoh devices are certified as safe, ventilation in some offices can allow even the safe levels of *VOC produced by Ricoh devices to build to levels that produce strong odors and health effects. In such cases, it is necessary to improve the ventilation of the immediate environment in which the Ricoh device is installed, in order to reduce particle concentration levels.

C. Deodorizing filter installation procedure

Locations of rear filter and fusing exhaust filter:





^{*}VOC: Volatile Organic Compounds are particles of the component materials (glues, plastics, chemicals, etc.) that Ricoh devices are built with.

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Attaching the rear filter:

Clean the exterior cover around the rear exhaust area using a cloth.
 Important: Make sure to thoroughly clean the contact area for the double-sided tape.



2. Attach the rear deodorizing filter as shown in the photo below.



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Attaching the fusing exhaust deodorizing filter:

3. Clean the exterior cover around the fusing exhaust area using a cloth. **Important:** Make sure to thoroughly clean the contact area for the double-sided tape.



4. Attach the fusing exhaust deodorizing filter as shown in the photo below.



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D. Limitations of the deodorizing filters

The following limitations exist with these filters:

If the temperature of the installation environment is 29C (84.2F) or higher:

- Continuous printing/copying should be limited to a maximum of 38 minutes
- The Auto Off Timer should be set to its default value (60 minutes)

This is because when the temperature is this high, the properties and behavior of the toner change, and image quality issues begin to occur.
