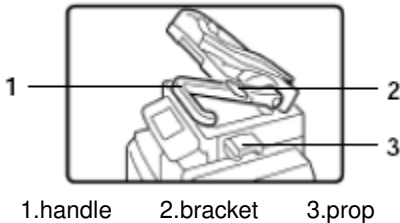

Document Feeder Handle Type 5: Safety Notes

Read the following instructions carefully and completely before using the Auto Document Feeder (ADF). Also, keep these instructions safe for future use. For safe and correct usage of the ADF, be sure to read " Safety Information " before beginning operations.

□ Safety Information

- Do not use the bracket to open or close the Auto Document Feeder (ADF). Doing so will damage the ADF and you risk injury if your fingers become trapped between the handle and the bracket.
- Keep your hands clear of the prop when opening and closing the ADF. You risk injury if your hand is between the prop and the handle when the handle is lowered.

□ Usage Cautions

- When the ADF is closed, make sure the handle is fully lowered.

- The ADF opens to an angle of approximately 60°. Do not force it open beyond its stopping point. Doing so will damage the ADF.
- When opening the ADF, make sure the handle is fully extended and directly under the bracket. The handle can be damaged if it is pushed down against the prop.



- The handle is jointed to minimize user obstruction and protect it from damage. Be sure to fully extend the handle before using it.
