System Requirements



 Spot Coating Editor for Acrobat may not operate normally when Adobe Acrobat is updated. In Adobe Acrobat, by default, [Automatically install updates] is enabled.

Spot Coating Editor for Acrobat is compatible with the following operating systems and versions of Adobe Acrobat. For the latest information, see the Ricoh home page.

Installing Spot Coating Editor for Acrobat



• If Spot Coating Editor for Acrobat is already installed, overwrite installation is possible. If overwrite installation is performed, all of the files installed will be overwritten.

Installing the Windows Version

- Check the installer file you need for the version of Adobe Acrobat that you have installed.
 For details about the installer file, see Spot Coating Editor for Acrobat Readme.txt.
- 2. Start the installer.
- 3. Select the language of the installer.




This will not appear if you are performing an overwrite installation.

4. When the setup wizard screen appears, click [Next].




5. Check the terms of the software license agreement. Select [I accept the terms in the License Agreement], and then click [Install].

Installation starts.




If Spot Coating Editor is already installed, the [Spot Coating Editor Setup] screen appears.

To perform overwrite installation, click [OK].




Overwrite installation starts when [OK] is clicked.

6. When the Installation Complete screen appears, click [Next].




7. Click [Finish] to close the setup wizard screen.

- Check the installer file you need for the version of Adobe Acrobat that you have installed.

- 2. Start the installer.
- 3. Click [Continue].



4. Check the terms of the software license agreement, and then click [Continue].




5. Click [Agree].




6. When the Installation Type screen appears, click [Install].

Mportant (

- If the Shift key is pressed when Adobe Acrobat is started, the plug-in is not loaded. Make sure that
 the Shift key is not being pressed when starting Adobe Acrobat.
- When [Use only certified plug-ins] is selected in the Preferences settings of Adobe Acrobat, Spot
 Coating Editor is not loaded and therefore, cannot be used. Follow the procedure below to change
 the configuration settings.
 - 1. Start Adobe Acrobat.
 - Open the [Preferences] screen by selecting [Edit] menu [Preferences] or [Edit] menu [Preferences] [General].
 - 3. Select [General] in [Categories:].
 - 4. Unselect the check box for [Use only certified plug-ins] of [Application Startup].
 - 5. Click the [OK] button and close the [Preferences] screen.
 - 6. Exit Adobe Acrobat.
 - 7. Restart Adobe Acrobat.
- 1. Start Adobe Acrobat.
- 2. Select [Open] from the [File] menu to open a PDF document.
- Follow the instructions below to open the Tool palette of Spot Coating Editor.
 - Acrobat XI:
 - 1. Click [Tool] on the toolbar to display the tool panel window.
 - 2. Click [Spot Coating Editor].
 - Acrobat DC
 - 1. Click the [Tool] tab.
 - Click [Add] below [Spot Coating Editor] in the [Add-ons] category.
 [Spot Coating Editor] is added on the panel window.
 - 3. Click [Spot Coating Editor].





Uninstalling the Windows Version


- 1. Start the uninstaller.
 - Windows 7, Windows Server 22003 R2/008/2008 R2:
 On the [Start] menu, select [Control Panel], and then click [Uninstall a program].
 - Windows 8/8.1, Windows Server 2012/2012 R2:
 Click [Settings] on the Charm Bar, and then click [Control Panel]. When the [Control Panel] window appears, click [Uninstall a program].
 - Windows 10
 Right-click the [Start] button on the desktop, and then click [Control Panel]. When the [Control Panel] window appears, click [Uninstall a program].
- 2. Select [Spot Coating Editor for Acrobat], and then click [Uninstall].
- 3. Click [Uninstall] in the uninstallation screen.







5. Click [Finish] to close the uninstallation wizard screen.




Uninstalling the Mac Version

- 1. Select [Go to Folder] from [Go] menu in the Finder.
- 2. Enter the path of the uninstaller in [Go to the folder], and then click [Go].

The uninstaller file is in the following path:

- Acrobat XI:
 - /Applications/Adobe Acrobat XI Pro/Adobe Acrobat Pro/Contents/Plug-ins/Spot Coating Editor
- Acrobat DC:
 - /Library/Application Support/Adobe/Acrobat/DC/Plug-ins/Spot Coating Editor If the classic version of Acrobat DC (Acrobat DC 2015) is installed:
 - /Library/Application Support/Adobe/Acrobat/2015/Plug-ins/Spot Coating Editor
- 3. Start the uninstaller.

4. Click [OK].



Uninstallation starts.

When uninstallation finishes, the completion screen appears.

5. Click [Close] to close the uninstallation screen.

Troubleshooting

Problems	Causes	Solutions
Spot Coating Editor for Acrobat cannot be installed.	The file that you want to install is in use by another application.	Quit the application and try again.
	The operating system you are using is not compatible with Spot Coating Editor for Acrobat.	Make sure to use an operating system that is compatible with this product. For a list of operating systems that are compatible with this software, see page 3 "System Requirements".
Spot Coating Editor for Acrobat cannot be uninstalled.	Spot Coating Editor for Acrobat is currently running.	Quit Adobe Acrobat, and then uninstall Spot Coating Editor for Acrobat.

Problems	Causes	Solutions
Spot Coating Editor does not appear on the tool panel of Adobe Acrobat.	The Shift key is being pressed when restarting Adobe Acrobat.	Exit Adobe Acrobat and then restarting Adobe Acrobat. Make sure that the Shift key is not being pressed when restarting Adobe Acrobat.
	The plug-in is not loaded.	When [Use only certified plug-ins] is selected in the Preferences settings of Adobe Acrobat, Spot Coating Editor is not loaded and therefore, cannot be used.
		Follow the procedure below to change the configuration settings.
		1. Start Adobe Acrobat.
		Open the [Preferences] screen by selecting [Edit] menu - [Preferences] or [Edit] menu - [Preferences] - [General].
		3. Select [General] in [Categories:].
		4. Unselect the check box for [Use only certified plug-ins] of [Application Startup].
		5. Click the [OK] button and close the [Preferences] screen.
		6. Exit Adobe Acrobat.
		7. Restart Adobe Acrobat.
