




# **Notes for Users**

The manuals contain additional information.

## **MARNING**

- The supplied power cord is for use with the supplied AC adapter only. Do not use it with any other adapter.
- If AC power to the machine is cut during operation by, for instance, the power plug being accidentally pulled out or a blackout occurring, the machine automatically switches to battery power.
   If the AC power is restored before the battery becomes exhausted, the machine automatically switches back to the AC power supply. The machine's power goes off when the battery becomes exhausted. If this happens, turn the power back on once the AC power is restored.
- The LED battery level indicator merely gives a rough indication of the battery level. If the battery level is low, recharge the battery using the AC adapter or replace the battery.
- If the battery has been left unused for a long time, fully recharge it before using it again.
- Before you move the machine, remove the battery and insulate the battery terminals with tape or
  put the battery in a plastic bag or the box it was delivered in. Moving the machine with the battery
  installed may cause a short circuit, leading to smoke or fire.
- Do not forget to turn off the light for checking printed documents.

#### **Power Source**

AC adapter for SG 3120B SFNw: 100 V-240 V 1.5A

Voltage must not fluctuate more than 10%.

Please be sure to connect the power cable to a power source as above.

Confirm that the wall outlet is near the machine and freely accessible, so that in event of an emergency, it can be unplugged easily.
