

Notes for Users

These notes supplement *Printer Reference 1* and *Printer Reference 2*.

Operating System

Microsoft Windows NT Server version 4.0 (ServicePack 5 or later) and Microsoft Windows NT Workstation (ServicePack 5 or later) changes to ServicePack 6 or later. Read the manual replacing “⁷ Requires Service Pack 4 or later” with “⁷ Requires Service Pack 6 or later” on p.A-2 “Printer Drivers for This Machine”, *Printer Reference 1*.

Printer Driver Version for Macintosh

Adobe PostScript 3 Driver version 8.8 can be also used. When using it, read the manual replacing “version 8.7.2” with “version 8.8” on p.A-25 “Macintosh - Installing the PostScript 3 Printer Driver”, *Printer Reference 1*.

Added New Function

A new function is added to the Adobe PostScript printer driver. This section explains about this new function, **[Select Resolution (lpi)]**.

Note

- ☐ This function is not added to PCL5e printer driver.

◆ **Select Resolution (lpi)**

When printing data that contains photographs, images may be unclear. If this is the case, set a higher value for image density and detail.

Note

- ☐ Appropriate values vary depending on image type. Change the value, and then make sure the image is clearer after printing.

This function is added to the tab for the operating system, as follows:

- Windows 95/98/Me

- ☐ When using Mac OS 10.2.x, this function is added to **[Set 3]** in **[Feature Sets]** under **[Printer Features]**.
