Relationship Between the Projection Distance and the Screen Size

The size of the projected image varies according to the distance from the projector to the screen. Refer to the following for the minimum screen size (the shortest projection distance) and the maximum screen size (the longest projection distance).

The procedures explained in this manual are for how to use the projector with a remote control.



Insert the connector of the power cord set into the AC In socket on the projector.



Insert the power plug into a power outlet.

The projector turns on in this step if [Power On Method] in [Default Settings 2] on the menu screen is set to [Auto.]. Proceed to step 4.

Press the (()) (Power) button.

Select the display language on the start menu the first time you turn on the projector after you purchase it.

The [Network Setting Wizard] screen appears after selecting the display language. To configure the network settings, see "Connecting the Projector to a Network", Operating Instructions P



The input signal is detected automatically and the image is projected. To project the image of a video player, press the play button on the video player. To project a laptop computer's screen, switch the computer's image output. If the projected image is not the one that you wanted to project, press the [Input] button to switch the input signal.

Note

- To change the display language, press the [Menu] button, and then select the display language in [Language / XXX] (XXX indicates the current display language) on the [🏟] tab.
- When connecting a laptop computer to the projector, switch the computer's image output. In Windows operating systems, the image output can be switched with a function key. While pressing and holding the [Fn] key, press the _/ key, the D key, or the LCD/VGA function key.
